## STATEMENT OF FAITH

SAIL is a parent led organization that seeks to support home schooling families by providing both academic, intermediate, and enrichment classes for older students. All classes are taught from or adhere to a Biblical perspective that emphasizes the following foundational truths:

- 1) The Bible is the inerrant, infallible Word of God.
- 2) God exists in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3) Man fell into sin through his disobedience.
- 4) Jesus Christ paid the penalty for mans' sin through His perfect life, His sacrificial death, and His triumphant resurrection.
- 5) Eternal life is available to those who confess and repent of their sin, and put their trust in Christ alone as their hope of salvation.
- 6) Christians have the Holy Spirit as an indwelling Person, enabling them to live lives of faith, repentance, virtue, and obedience.

Since different denominations and viewpoints exist within the larger Christian community, SAIL seeks to abide by the following basic principle:

***"In essentials, unity; in non-essentials, liberty; in all things, charity."***

SAIL classes are offered as a Biblically-based educational option for Christian families. Participating families are not required to adhere to the statement of faith above. However, all SAIL parents and students should recognize that classes are taught from a Christian perspective, particularly when dealing with world views, and/or discussions of origins, history, ethics, and literature.

**PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT**

We hereby agree to comply with the following rules for the 2012-2013 session of SAIL

Be on time. Students agree to be on time for classes. If participating in a first period class, students will be in their rooms ready to go five minutes before the class starts. No student will be admitted for first period after 9 am without contacting either the teacher or front desk prior to being late.

Exhibit appropriate behavior/attitudes and proper respect for authority; good manners; indoor voices; loving, kind and patient attitudes towards others. As brothers and sisters in Christ, we desire to affirm and encourage each other. This includes being respectful of Calvary Church of the Brethren and the property of the church.

Attire: modesty is our policy, for both guys and girls. Inappropriate dress will not be accepted. Students will need to put on the 'modesty shirt' at SAIL if their clothing is deemed to be inappropriate.

Phone calls: Cell phones may be carried by students for emergency use only. We encourage our students to be responsible; phone calls for lunches, homework, etc. that were left at home are discouraged.

Personal Property: NO CD players, GAME Boys, Ipods, trading cards, or other distractions are allowed at SAIL.

If students are on the church property, they are required to be in class. **No student is to be left unsupervised at any time. Parent are not to drop off students at CCOB unless the students are in a class.** Parents agree to promptly pick up students at the end of their final class.

Parents are not to congregate in the hallways of CCOB. If a child is enrolled in for only one class, parents may wait in the parking lot, in their vehicles. Siblings are not to be unsupervised in the church parking lot or on church property.

Discipline by teacher during class will be as follows:

Students will be given two warnings concerning inappropriate behavior. If the student continues to act out, he/she will be required to leave the class for the day, and parents will be notified. If inappropriate behavior continues, student will be asked to leave the class for the rest of the session. No refund will be given.

Teachers will arbitrate conflicts/ offenses between children to help them reconcile differences following the Biblical pattern of confession, repentance, forgiveness, and reconciliation. (Mt. 18:15; Gal 6:1; Eph. 4:15; Rom. 15:14) Parents may be notified.

Recognizing that class space is limited, students who enroll in classes with homework agree to complete required work. It is the student's responsibility to contact the teacher for assignments when absent from class. If a student does not complete class assignments, he may be asked to leave the class, and no refund will be given.

Cheating will not be tolerated. Students who cheat on an assignments, tests, etc., will be dismissed from SAIL and no refund will be given. **Copying information from the internet without proper documentation is plagiarism and will be considered cheating.**

Parents who are dissatisfied with some aspect of SAIL should speak to the appropriate person, whether teacher, director or board member. If a parent or child has been hurt or offended by a SAIL member, we ask that person take responsibility to go to them in the spirit of peace and speak the truth in love, seeking reconciliation.

**By signing this agreement, parents agree that they have carefully considered which classes meet the needs of their students and understand that ALL fees must be paid by the due date. Communication must be given and approved as to why payment cannot be made on time. You will receive a reminder in mid-May of payment being due June 1. If not made by June 1, you will be sent one reminder by email. If payment is still not received and communication not made and approved you will subsequently be charged a \$20 late fee added to the second portion of your tuition payment which will be due September 1.**

**No refund will given if a student is unable to complete any SAIL session.**

Course fees are as follows: Academic classes: \$123/ year; Intermediate classes: \$93/ year; Enrichment classes: \$63 /year.

Parents agree to assume all risks, hazards, and costs incidental to participation at SAIL, and agree to release and to hold blameless the teachers, assistants, parent helpers, board members, and Calvary Church of the Brethren for any accident, injury, or loss suffered during SAIL.
