

Participation Agreement

We hereby agree to comply with the following rules for the 2011-2012 session of Jr. SAIL:

Be on time: Students agree to be on time for classes. If participating in a first period class, students should be in the sanctuary at 9:10am. Please do not bring students before 9am.

Exhibit appropriate behavior/attitudes: Proper respect for authority; good manners; indoor voices; loving, kind and patient attitudes towards others. As brothers and sisters in Christ, we desire to affirm and encourage each other. This includes being respectful of the New Hope Alliance Church (NHAC) property.

Attire: Modesty is our policy, for both guys and girls.

Phone calls & personal property: NO rollershoes, CD players, GAME Boys, iPods, trading cards, toys or cell phones are allowed. These items will be confiscated on the first offense and returned only to the parent. Students can call a parent if necessary using one of the Administrators' cell phones at the front desk.

If students are on the church property, they are required to be in class. No student is to be left unsupervised at any time. Parents agree to promptly pick up students at the end of their final class and accompany students in and out of the building. NO student will be allowed outside without a parent and dropping off at the curb is not allowed for safety reasons.

Parents are not to congregate in the hallways or foyer of NHAC. Siblings are not to be unsupervised in the church parking lot or on church property.

Discipline by teachers during class will be as follows:

Students will be given two warnings during a class period for inappropriate behavior. If the student continues to act out, he/she will be required to leave the class for the day, and parents will be notified. If inappropriate behavior continues, student will be asked to leave the class for the rest of the session. No refund will be given.

Teachers will arbitrate conflicts/ offenses between children to help them reconcile differences following the Biblical pattern of confession, repentance, forgiveness, and reconciliation. (Mt. 18:15; Gal 6:1; Eph. 4:15; Rom. 15:14) Parents may be notified.

Homework: Recognizing that class space is limited, students who enroll in classes with homework agree to complete required work. It is the student's responsibility to contact the teacher for assignments when absent from class. If a student does not complete class assignments, he may be asked to leave the class, and no refund will be given.

Parents who are dissatisfied with some aspect of Jr. SAIL should speak to the appropriate person, whether teacher, Jr. SAIL director or board member. If a parent or child has been hurt or offended by a Jr. SAIL member, we ask that person take responsibility to go to them in the spirit of peace and speak the truth in love, seeking reconciliation.

By signing this agreement, parents agree that they have carefully considered which classes meet the needs of their students and understand that all fees must be paid by the due date. No refund will be given if a student is unable to complete any Jr. SAIL session. ALL FEES ARE NONREFUNDABLE.

Volunteer duties: Parents are required (unless prior approval is given by the Administrators) to help with clean up and/or assist teachers in classes two half days per semester. Upon fulfillment of each semester's volunteer time, half the volunteer fee of \$40 will be refunded. If a parent is unable to help on their assigned day for any reason, they are responsible for finding a substitute and their fee will be paid to their substitute. PARENT VOLUNTEER TIME IS REQUIRED FOR STUDENT PARTICIPATION.

Parents agree to assume all risks, hazards, and costs incidental to participation at Jr. SAIL, and agree to release and to hold blameless the teachers, assistants, parent helpers, board members, and NHAC for any accident, injury, or loss suffered during Jr. SAIL.
